Air Canada has been named 'Best Long Haul Airline in the Americas' for 2018 by AirlineRatings.com. It is also the only international network carrier in North America to receive a Four-Star ranking according to independent UK research firm Skytrax.

In 2017 – Air Canada's 80th anniversary year – the airline served close to 48 million customers, ranking among the 20 largest airlines in the world. Air Canada continues to renew its international fleet and in June 2018 will introduce its newest single-aisle aircraft, the Boeing 737 MAX 8. It will feature a Premium Economy and Economy cabin configuration and be deployed on new routes from Ireland as well as select UK services. In addition, Air Canada now operates 31 state-of-the-art and fuel-efficient Boeing 787 Dreamliners, with seven more scheduled to be delivered by the end of 2019.

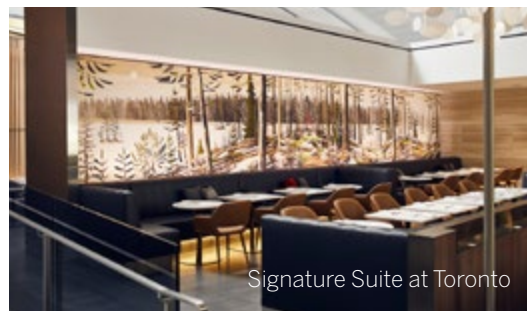
